SPEYSIDE

- Balvenie 14yo Caribbean Cask Finish** £7.80
Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples and mangoes with a hint of orange in the background.
- Benriach 'The Twelve' 12yo** £6.20
Honeyed cereals, cooked apple, chocolate peanuts and soft, almost jammy sultanas.
- Glen Grant 18yo Rare Edition** £12.50
Malty caramel, delicate, dried raisins, vanilla, sweet with hints of nuts and spice.
- Linkwood Madeira Cask Finish. Bottled by Murray McDavid.** £5.60
Caramelized fruits, honey, oak spice, and nutty Madeira wine influence.
- The Macallan 12yo Sherry Cask Finish** £9.20
Rich dried fruits, Christmas cake, dark chocolate, cinnamon, and oak.

HIGHLANDS

- Ardnamurchan AD/** £6
Honeyed malt, briny sea air, citrus zest, dark chocolate, and a gentle peat smoke.
- Edradour 10yo** £5.80
Rich dried fruits, sherry sweetness, vanilla, and nutty undertones.
- Glencadam Pinot Noir Cask Finish** £7.20
An oily palate carries flavours of Black Forest gâteau, woody spices, toffee apples, vanilla custard, and cinnamon.
- Glenfarclas 10yo** £5.60
Sherry-soaked raisins, malted barley, vanilla, and oak spice.
- Old Pulteney 15yo** £8
Matured in both bourbon and Spanish oak casks resulting in a splendid balance of sweetness and spice.

ISLAY

- Ardbeg Hypernova - Committee Release** £22
Explosive peat smoke, ashy barbecue, charred wood, and herbal complexity. One of Ardbeg's most heavily peated releases, designed for the Ardbeg Committee members.
- Ardbeg Smoketrail Manzanilla Edition** £11.80
Salty maritime smoke, lemon zest, nutty dryness, and earthy peat. Finished in Manzanilla sherry casks.
- Ardbeg 8yo 'For Discussion' - Committee Release** £7.20
Intense bonfire smoke, citrus oil, black pepper, and vanilla sweetness.
- Laphroaig Lore** £8
Intense peat smoke, sea salt, medicinal notes, dark chocolate, and spicy oak.
- Port Charlotte 10yo** £6.60
Heavily peated smoke, citrus, toasted oak, vanilla, and seaweed brine.

ISLANDS

- Arran Bodega Sherry Finish – Isle of Arran** £6.40
Rich dark fruits, chocolate, coffee, toasted oak, and spiced orange peel.
- Highland Park 12yo - Orkney** £6.30
Rather full of a pleasant depth. Lurking somewhere in the substratum a grilled orange lies. Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine.
- Ledaig Rioja Cask Finish - Sinclair Series – Isle of Mull** £5.60
Peaty smoke, dark berries, red wine tannins, and coastal brine.
- Lagg Kilmory – Isle of Arran** £5.80
Earthy peat smoke, citrus, vanilla, toffee, and maritime salt.
- Whitlaw 10yo. Bottled by Signatory Vintage – Orkney** £6
Mouth-filling, soft and spicy with strong notes of heather and fresh herbs - followed by slight hints of dried fruits.

LOWLANDS

- Bladnoch Vinaya** £5.80
Fresh orchard fruits, honey, vanilla, light oak, and gentle spice. A smooth, well-balanced Lowland whisky.
- Finglassie 4yo Chinkapin Finish (cask 726). Bottled by Fragrant Drops (Keeble Cask Co.)** £7.50
Distilled in 2020, this characterful Lowlander spent four years maturing, finishing up in a fresh chinquapin oak barrel. A release of 253 bottles.
- Littlemill 12yo** £34
Light floral notes, citrus zest, honey, vanilla, and soft oak spice. Littlemill was Scotland's oldest licensed distillery before closing permanently in the 1990s, making its whisky highly sought after.

CAMPBELTOWN

- Campbeltown Loch Blend** £6
A blended whisky made by Springbank, using a combination of their single malts. Well-balanced mix of malt and grain whisky, featuring caramel, spice, and subtle peat smoke.
- Glen Scotia 15yo** £7.40
Creamy, nutty, with vanilla, spice, and a hint of maritime brine.
- Kilkerran 5yo Online Tasting Week 2021** £17
Young and bold with fresh barley, sea spray, and a peppery finish.
- Kilkerran 8yo Cask Strength** £8.50
Oily, malty, with citrus zest, vanilla, and a lingering smoky minerality.
- Kilkerran 12yo** £7.20
Honeyed malt, soft peat smoke, vanilla, and hints of maritime salt.
- Hazelburn 8yo** £18
Unpeated and smooth, with toffee, dried fruit, and a creamy mouthfeel.
- Springbank 10yo Amontillado Cask Finish** £13
Nutty, sherried, with earthy peat smoke, dried fruit, and caramel.
- Springbank 12yo** £9
Medium-sweet, big-bodied, and rich with dark peaty touch.
- Springbank 15yo** £11
Rich and full-bodied, with dark chocolate, dried fruit, and gentle peat smoke.
