<b>Linkwood Madeira Finish (Murray McDavid Bottling)</b> Caramelized fruits, honey, oak spice, and nutty Madeira wine influence.	<b>£5.60</b>
<b>Balvenie 12yo Caribbean Cask</b> Honeyed malt, tropical fruit, toffee, vanilla, and gentle oak spice.	<b>£7.80</b>
<b>The Macallan 12yo Sherry Cask</b> Rich dried fruits, Christmas cake, dark chocolate, cinnamon, and oak.	<b>£9.20</b>

<b>Edradour 10yo</b> Rich dried fruits, sherry sweetness, vanilla, and nutty undertones.	<b>£5.80</b>

<b>Ardnamurchan AD/</b> Honeyed malt, briny sea air, citrus zest, dark chocolate, and a gentle peat smoke.	<b>£6.00</b>

#### ISLAY

<b>Laphroaig Lore</b> Intense peat smoke, sea salt, medicinal notes, dark chocolate, and spicy oak.	<b>£8</b>
<b>Port Charlotte 10yo</b> Heavily peated smoke, citrus, toasted oak, vanilla, and seaweed brine.	<b>£6.60</b>
<b>Ardbeg Hypernova Committee Release</b> Explosive peat smoke, ashy barbecue, charred wood, and herbal complexity. One of Ardbeg's most heavily peated releases, designed for the Ardbeg Committee members.	<b>£22</b>
<b>Ardbeg Smoketrail Manzanilla Edition</b> Salty maritime smoke, lemon zest, nutty dryness, and earthy peat. Finished in Manzanilla sherry casks.	<b>£11.80</b>
<b>Ardbeg 8yo For Discussion Committee Release</b> Intense bonfire smoke, citrus oil, black pepper, and vanilla sweetness.	<b>£7.20</b>

## ISLANDS

<b>Ledaig Rioja Finish</b>	<b>£5.60</b>
Peaty smoke, dark berries, red wine tannins, and coastal brine.	
<b>Lagg Kilmory</b>	<b>£5.80</b>
Earthy peat smoke, citrus, vanilla, toffee, and maritime salt.	
<b>Arran Bodega Sherry</b>	<b>£6.40</b>
Rich dark fruits, chocolate, coffee, toasted oak, and spiced orange peel.	

## LOWLANDS

<b>Bladnoch Vinaya</b>	<b>£5.80</b>
Fresh orchard fruits, honey, vanilla, light oak, and gentle spice. A smooth, well-balanced Lowland whisky.	
<b>Littlemill 12yo</b>	<b>£34</b>
Light floral notes, citrus zest, honey, vanilla, and soft oak spice. Littlemill was Scotland's oldest licensed distillery before closing permanently in the 1990s, making its whisky highly sought after.	

## CAMPBELTOWN

<b>Campbeltown Loch Blend</b>	<b>£6</b>
A blended whisky made by Springbank, using a combination of their single malts. Well-balanced mix of malt and grain whisky, featuring caramel, spice, and subtle peat smoke.	
<b>Kilkerran 8yo Cask Strength</b>	<b>£8.50</b>
Oily, malty, with citrus zest, vanilla, and a lingering smoky minerality.	
<b>Kilkerran 5yo Online Tasting Week 2021</b>	<b>£17</b>
Young and bold with fresh barley, sea spray, and a peppery finish.	
<b>Kilkerran 12yo</b>	<b>£7.20</b>
Honeyed malt, soft peat smoke, vanilla, and hints of maritime salt.	
<b>Hazelburn 8yo</b>	<b>£18</b>
Unpeated and smooth, with toffee, dried fruit, and a creamy mouthfeel.	
<b>Springbank 12 yo</b>	<b>£9</b>
<i>Medium-sweet, big-bodied, and rich with dark peaty touch.</i>	
<b>Springbank 10yo Amontillado Cask</b>	<b>£13</b>
Nutty, sherried, with earthy peat smoke, dried fruit, and caramel.	
<b>Springbank 15yo</b>	<b>£11</b>
Rich and full-bodied, with dark chocolate, dried fruit, and gentle peat smoke.	
<b>Glen Scotia 15yo</b>	<b>£7.40</b>
Creamy, nutty, with vanilla, spice, and a hint of maritime brine.	

## Ireland

<b>Green Spot Chateau Barton Bordeaux</b>	<b>£7</b>
Red berries, vanilla, toasted oak, and spice from the wine cask finish. Finished in French Bordeaux wine casks from Château Léoville Barton.	
<b>Connemara Peated</b>	<b>£5.60</b>
Smoky, sweet, with vanilla, heather honey, and a soft maltiness.	
<b>Fercullen 8yo</b>	<b>£5.80</b>
Creamy, with honey, vanilla, citrus, and a soft oaky finish.	
<b>Redbreast 12yo</b>	<b>£6.40</b>
Rich sherry influence, nuts, dried fruits, and a long, smooth finish.	
<b>Glendalough Double Barrel</b>	<b>£5.40</b>
Vanilla, caramel, dried fruit, and spice from bourbon and sherry cask maturation.	
<b>Temris 5yo Pedro Ximénez Finish</b>	<b>£6.80</b>
Dark fruits, chocolate, nutmeg, and a smooth sherried richness. A limited-release whisky with a deep, sweet profile from PX sherry casks.	

## American Bourbon

<b>Eagle Rare</b>	<b>£6.00</b>
Rich caramel, dark chocolate, toasted oak, and a hint of orange zest.	
<b>Shenk's Homestead 2024</b>	<b>£15.40</b>
Spicy, with caramel, nutmeg, vanilla, and toasted oak.	
<b>Westland Peated</b>	<b>£6.80</b>
Earthy peat smoke, dark chocolate, espresso, and roasted nuts. One of the few American single malts with significant peat influence.	
<b>Blanton's Single Barrel</b>	<b>£8.60</b>
Rich caramel, citrus, spice, and a smooth vanilla finish.	
<b>Buffalo Trace Traveller</b>	<b>£5.40</b>
Vanilla, caramel, spice, and a smooth oak finish.	

## American Rye

<b>Rittenhouse Rye</b>	<b>£5.60</b>
Bold spice, cinnamon, vanilla, and a touch of dark fruit.	
<b>Michter's US*1 Straight Rye</b>	<b>£6.80</b>
Black pepper, caramel, dried fruit, and a hint of tobacco.	
<b>Willet 4yo Family Estate Bottled Rye</b>	<b>£6.80</b>
Spicy rye notes, caramel, dark chocolate, gingerbread and cracked black pepper.

Sweet malt, vanilla, honey, and a light oak finish.

### Hatozaki 12yo Umeshu Finish

£8.50

Floral, stone fruits, plum wine sweetness, and light spice. Finished in Umeshu (plum wine) casks, creating a unique Japanese twist.

### Kaiyo Peated

£11

Peaty, tropical fruit, vanilla, and maritime brine. Kaiyo matures its whisky at sea, giving it an unusual aging process.

### Fuji Gotemba Single Malt

Delicate fruit, honey, malt, and a light smokiness.

### Hibiki Harmony

£8.80

Floral, honey, citrus, and light oak spice with a smooth texture.

### Nikka Taketsuru Pure Malt (2020 Release)

Malt-forward, with dried fruit, toffee, and light smoke.

### Te Bheag Nan Eilean

Light, fruity, with soft caramel and a touch of maritime salt. A blend of Irish and Scottish styles, featuring a slight peaty note.

### Kavalan Distillery Select | Taiwan

Tropical fruits, vanilla, toffee, and a hint of spice.

### Penderyn Celt | Wales

Light smoke, vanilla, citrus, and fresh apple. Finished in peated casks, giving it a gentle smokiness while maintaining the signature light and fruity Penderyn style.

50/50 Islay whisky and Canadian corn whisky. Heavy peat smoke, briny seaweed, caramel sweetness, and rich malt.
